Team Roles

Build Lead	Leads in the planning and execution phase. Collects, Considers and Summarizes ideas from the team.
Presentation Lead	Leads in overall presentations for the team including Narration, Directing, & Writing
Resource Lead	Ensures all materials are considered and used creatively
Coordinator	Ensures the Team has adequate time to plan, test and finish all parts.
Strategist	Determines a strategy based on the scoring areas. Finds alternative solutions.


